REMARKS OF VISITORS

Janet Noble, 333 North Gore, stated that there is not a curb on her street and she would like to get one. Over the years, the garbage service has changed and they routinely run over the side of my yard. So I would like it for numerous reasons because of that, the UPS truck, the FedEx Truck, there is a pizza delivery guy who tries to turn around on a neighbor across from me. She has an extended driveway made of gravel. If someone tries to turn around quickly, I get gravel in the street on Cheney and then it falls in my yard. So I'd like to have a curb on my side of the street if at all possible. I talked to the Street Department about this last summer and the director told me it was not wide enough. But I went up to Larson Park and there is a street over there that is just the same width as my street. Then I went to the County assessor's office in Clayton and got a plat and it is 12-13 inches. So I would really appreciate it if I could have a curb on my side of the street. Plus I talked to the Trash Department to see if we could get a smaller truck to come down Cheney, and he said Webster signed a contract that to go on streets they have to have a larger truck. So I guess all the people who don't have a curb on their street get their property run over. I don't know. I need some help with this situation if at all possible.

Mayor Welch stated that they would refer this to Public Works and someone would get in touch with her.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A PAVILION AND SIGNAGE AT SOUTHWEST PARK

Scott Davis, Director of Parks and Recreation, gave a brief presentation on the project. We are still about \$5,000 over budget on the total project. The Webster Groves Baseball/Softball League has committed to fund \$2,500 of that for electrical costs. The remainder would come out of the Park Improvement Fund. The total project will be a new pavilion situated between the parking lot and the restrooms, and the ballfield and playground, and a new sign.


ADJOURNMENT
