- Pamela Bliss won a Council Member position with 3,075 votes.
- Weston R. Ackermann received 694 votes.
- David Franklin won a Council Member position with 2,156 votes.
- Ron Zager received 1,613 votes.
- There were 57 Invalid Write-In Votes.
