New Fire House on Its Way

For the past several years, the City has engaged in planning for and funding a new Fire House on South Elm. The less than favorable conditions of the current inadequate house were the reasons for pursuing a new, up-to-date facility that would better serve the community and provide space to operate in a safe environment for fire personnel.

The process began with a site evaluation, then moved to preliminary architectural planning. Once a preliminary plan was developed, cost estimates were ascertained and a plan to fund the new facility was put in place. Ultimately, our citizens voted to fund this facility with a bond issue.

Site work has now begun! For those who have driven by or live in the neighborhood, you will notice that the houses to the south of and to the east of the current fire house have been recently demolished to provide added space for the new facility.

We will keep you updated as construction moves along.

- South Rock Hill from Reavis Place to West Rose
- Atalanta Avenue from Bompart to Summit
