Maintenance Worker I (Laborer)

The City of Webster Groves is accepting applications for a full-time Maintenance Worker I in the Streets Division. Responsible for maintenance, construction and repair of City streets, rights-of-way, sidewalks, buildings or related facilities. Performs duties in a manner that encourages good public relations and instills trust and respect within the community. Work assignments may be in any of the maintenance program areas including, but not limited to HVAC, buildings, streets, and sign shop.

- Two years of similar full-time work experience is required.
- Minimum High School Diploma/GED with a valid Missouri or Illinois Class F driver's license required, with ability to obtain the required **Class B CDL** with air brakes endorsement within three months.

Requires ability to perform heavy manual labor, with exposure to outdoor weather conditions for sustained periods, including ability to regularly lift 50 lbs.

Regular schedule is to work days, **Monday through Friday**, but also requires ability to work overtime hours during evenings/nights, holidays, and weekends, as needed.

Starting salary **\$34,687** annually with excellent benefits, including tuition reimbursement and scholarship program through Webster University.

Job Title: Maintenance Worker I

General Purpose

The position performs semi-skilled tasks to construct city owned facilities within the public right-of-way and repair and maintain building, and/or related facilities within the City, performing the duties in a manner that encourages good public relations and instills trust and respect within the community. Work assignments may be in any of the maintenance program areas including HVAC ,Buildings ,Public Works etc....

Essential Duties

Standard

- Paint city buildings and facilities.
- Assist skilled personnel in areas of carpentry, plumbing, pipefitting, HVAC and minor electrical and other mechanical work.
- Performs tasks manually or using equipment related to maintenance of streets, sidewalks and storm water inlets and grates in the City.
- Performs tasks to cut and break pavement which is to be removed for street repair.
- Digs hauls, and shovels soil, sand, gravel, asphalt, concrete, etc. and rakes and tamps asphalt as part of street maintenance duties.
- Places and removes cones and traffic barricades as warning devices to secure safety at work sites, directs traffic when necessary.
- Assists in forming, mixing, pouring, troweling and finishing concrete and masonry used in maintenance jobs.
- Assists with the installation and repair of street signs and the layout and painting of pavement striping and marking.
- Installs concrete form work for streets and sidewalks.
- Performs activities related to snow cleanup to include operating snowplow truck, spreading chemicals, and shoveling as assigned.
- Assists in trimming and cutting trees and shrubbery, removing tree trunks and shrubbery, and shredding plant debris.

Essential Duties (continued)

- Performs activities related to installation and clean up after special events, disasters, accidents, etc
- Sweeps and shovels debris and litter, moving heavy objects and loading into trucks.
- Assists with routine maintenance of power equipment and vehicles.
- Performs "pre-trip" safety check of vehicle on a daily basis.
- Performs other duties within Public Works as assigned.
- Encourages and makes recommendations for efficiencies, processes, etc. which will deliver either quality and cost savings improvements within the department and across the City.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education, Experience & Training for Performing Essential Functions

High school diploma/GED required. Minimum two years of related work experience. Valid Class E license required with ability to obtain the required Class B CDL with air brakes endorsement within three months. Any HVAC Experience or Electrical training is a Plus. Possess the ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

Work Environment and Physical Demands

Ability to work evenings and nights. Ability to work overtime including weekends and holidays if needed. Frequently assumes positions of stooping, kneeling, crawling, crouching, squatting, twisting and climbing, sometimes in confined spaces. Ability to sit, stand and walk. Ability to use hands and arms to reach and lift as coordinated or independent functions. Perform heavy manual labor for sustained periods of time. Exert physical strength necessary to operate all equipment used in daily departmental activities. Lift 50 pounds on a normal basis. Exposure to outdoor weather conditions, chemicals, loud noises, electrical hazards, and dust.
